Meet our presenter: Michael Sanchez, OFS

Mike has a long history of knowing, loving and following Christ in the footsteps of St. Francis of Assisi.

After a conversion experience very much like Francis's own (except mental/emotional trauma preceded it rather than an illness) providence led Mike to become aware of St. Francis - his life story, love of Christ and teachings - and Mike was profoundly inspired (heard the call of God - a vocation) to follow his simple, humble and very good way of life. Mike was professed at 21 and has followed Francis for the last 45 years of his life.

He is currently the minister (and part-time co-formation director) of St. Joseph's Fraternity, Los Angeles. This is his fifth term as minister. He is married to Kelly and is also the father of two sons Matteo, 24, recently graduated from UNM and Luke, a young man, 22, with cerebral palsy and mental deficits. He is also retired (as of December 2024) after 34 years as a probation officer (law enforcement) with the county of Los Angeles. Besides his work with the OFS, he is involved ecumenically in preaching/teaching/counseling with various protestant Churches and organizations sharing the riches of Catholic doctrine/tradition. Mike also has a long history of involvement with the Charismatic Movement in Los Angeles - teaching, preaching, healing and operating prophetically.

Retired now he is determined to serve Christ more fully in our Franciscan family in whatever way God directs until 'the race' is over and he is called home.



Mike will offer a 5-part presentation (see Retreat Agenda for schedule):

- 1. Introduction: "Weeping may endure the night but Joy comes in the morning!" Psalm 30:5.
- 2. One with all our Creation-family, we join in worship and praise, glorifying our Heavenly Father, celebrating His goodness and love! *Luke 19:40. Psalms145:19, 65:8, 98:4 and 150:6.*
- God's love invites us to healing forgiveness even as His love compels us to show healing mercy to all who hurt us. Matthew 5:7. Luke 6:36, 37.
- 4. Through thorns God's power becomes manifest and through the blessed door of sister Death we enter eternal joy! 2 Corinthians 12:8,9. Acts 2:26-28, 2 Corinthians 5:1-4.
- 5. Exhortation: Let us delight our Heavenly Father with praise and with humble service to Him through others even as Jesus did, serving us by giving His life "a ransom for many". *Matthew 20:28. John 13:14,15 and 12:26.*
